PNCB Policy/ADA Test Accommodations

It is the policy of the Pediatric Nursing Certification Board, Inc. (PNCB) to readily comply with all applicable provisions of the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Under the ADA, an individual with a disability is a person who: (1) has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities; OR (2) has a record of such an impairment; OR (3) is regarded as having such an impairment.

The PNCB provides appropriate forms to assist exam candidates in their request for special testing accommodations. Written medical documentation of stated disability must accompany each application for special testing accommodations. The PNCB will review all exam candidates' written requests for special accommodations at the time of application review. It is the policy of the PNCB to make every effort to accommodate candidates with disabilities.

PNCB strives to accommodate all requests related to assisting an individual with a disability.

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
